

G20 Dialogue on Water Water Coordination Roadmap

Context and Objective

- 2 The ongoing G20 discussion on sustainable and resilient water management has revealed the importance
- 3 of coordinating water-related activities and actions across G20 workstreams. This **Roadmap**, which is
- 4 voluntary and non-binding, aims to provide a coordination approach to ensure the coherency and
- 5 efficiency of existing water-related activities and actions taking place within the G20 workstreams and
- 6 working groups. This will optimize the impacts of water-related activities in the G20 forum through
- 7 increased synergy, knowledge-sharing, and voluntary collaboration across relevant workstreams, where
- 8 and when possible.

- 10 The roadmap consists of steps and a term period towards providing and voluntarily applying a non-
- binding approach on sustainable water management within the framework of the G20 mandates.
- 12 The 2020 Saudi G20 Presidency will carry out the steps indicated below:
 - 1. In **June and July**, the G20 Presidency will compile an inventory of water-related activities in all G20 tracks this G20 Stocktaking Inventory of Water-Related Activities ¹ (referred to as "Stocktaking Inventory") will be documented in a Saudi presidency report.
 - 2. In August:
 - The G20 Presidency will share the draft Stocktaking Inventory with the Dialogue on Water participants.
 - August 24th: the G20 Presidency will present the Stocktaking Inventory during the Dialogue on Water meeting on August 24, 2020.
 - 3. In **September**, the Presidency will publish the final version of the Stocktaking Inventory on the official G20 website.
- Moving forward towards future years, upcoming G20 Presidencies may voluntarily carry out the following activities according to the framework of the G20 mandates.
 - 1. Update the Stocktaking Inventory.
 - 2. Invite relevant G20 Working Groups and Engagement Groups to provide brief presentations about their water-related activities and present the best practices collected from members of these groups through the dialogue on water, as appropriate.
 - 3. Publish an updated, expanded and Stocktaking Inventory reflecting the information collected.
 - 4. Based on the discussions, prepare and agree by consensus a proposal for a coordination approach for water-related activities and actions in the G20 workstreams and working groups.
