Airworthiness Directive

The undermentioned examinations or modifications are mandatory.

- 1. Applies to: Kawasaki BK117 series helicopters
- 2. Compliance is required as indicated, unless already accomplished.

 To prevent injury to persons on the ground or a hoisting accident due to the failed overload clutch of the hoist, accomplish the following.
 - 2.1 Before next flight involving a hoist operation or within 30 days after the effective date of this AD, determine the Part Number (P/N) of the rescue hoist assembly installed on the helicopter.
- 2.2 If, as a result of the determination required by paragraph 2.1 of this AD, Goodrich rescue hoist assembly is installed with P/N listed in Kawasaki Service Bulletin No.KSB-117-361A or any further JCAB-approved revisions (here in after referred to as SB), Before next flight involving a hoist operation or within 30 days after the effective date of this AD, accomplish the following actions:
 - 2.2.1 Perform a cable conditioning lift in accordance with the instructions of SB.
 - 2.2.2 Perform a load check test in accordance with the instructions of SB.
 - 2.2.3 If the hoist fails the load check test as required by paragraph 2.2 of this AD, before next flight, remove the hoist, or replace the hoist with a serviceable hoist.
- 2.3 An alternative means of compliance with this AD may be used, if approved by the Director-General of JCAB.
- 3. Remarks
- 3.1 This AD becomes effective on April 4 2013.
- 3.2 Kawasaki Service Bulletin No.KSB-117-361A dated March 22, 2013 and

later JCAB approved revisions pertain to this subject.
