Aeronautical Consultations between Japan and the State of Israel

The consultations between the aeronautical authorities of Japan and the State of Israel were held on 7 and 8 July 2015 in Tokyo, and the two have shared the view as follows:

1. Delegations

The Japanese side was led by Mr. Yuji Yanagisawa, Chief Air Talks Officer, Air Talks Office, Civil Aviation Bureau, Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, accompanying other representatives.

The Israeli side was led by Mr. Ishay Don Yehiya, Director, Economic & International Affairs Division, Civil Aviation Authority of Israel, accompanying other representatives.

2. Summary

- (1) Route and Capacity were expanded so as to enable the airlines of each country to operate fourteen (14) flights per week at Narita International Airport.
- (2) Liberalized framework for Code-Sharing was established from the standpoint of expanding operational flexibility for the airlines of each country.
