Permission for International Air Transport Services by Foreign Nationals:

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport, and Tourism (MLIT) has announced that as of July 14, 2017, it has approved the application of Tiger Airways Singapore Pte Ltd to bring services into Japan based on its "Permission for International Air Transport Services by Foreign Nationals."

- 1. Applicant: Tiger Airways Singapore Pte Ltd
- 2. Scheduled date of operation: July 25, 2017 (Tuesday)
- 3. Air routes and number of flights:

Singapore – Taipei – Narita: 7 flights per week (Every day of the week)
Singapore – Bangkok – Narita: 7 flights per week (Every day of the week)
Singapore – Kaohsiung – Osaka: 3 flights per week (Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday)
Singapore – Bangkok – Osaka: 3 flights per week (Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday)
Singapore – Taipei – New Chitose: 3 flights per week (Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday)

The applicant will merge with its brother company, Scoot Pte Ltd (Scoot), a wholly owned subsidiary LCC of Singapore Airlines, on July 25 this year.

After the merger, the company name will be Scoot Tigerair Pte Ltd (Scoot Tigerair). Scoot Tigerair will take over current flights en route to Japan operated by Scoot. On that note, there will be no changes in flight routes, number of flights, and timetable. While the company's name will change to Scoot Tigerair, the brand will be unified to Scoot's brand. Therefore, there is no apparent change for passengers of flights enroute Japan.
