In Japan, we still recall the tremendous success of the World Horticultural Exhibition held in Tsurumi Ryokuchi Park, Osaka in 1990, which was the first A1 class event of this kind to be held in Asia.

The city of Yokohama is now preparing to host a World Horticultural Exhibition in 2027. Adopting the theme of "Scenery of The Future for Happiness," the event would be held on the site of the former Kamiseya communication facility, which was returned to Japan in 2015.
