
Look at the Future of Our Earth through the *Global Map*



The *Global Map* is digital geographic data sets composed of the thematic 8 layers;

1 Elevation, 2 Vegetation(Percent Tree Cover), 3 Land Cover, 4 Land Use, 5 Transportation, 6 Boundary, 7 Drainage, 8 Population Centers.

It covers the whole land area of the globe, in 1km resolution.

The first version of Global Map was released in 2008 on the initiative of the Japanese Government in collaboration with ISCGM and participating organizations.

The Global Map will serve for the discussion on global issues, including Climate Change.

The *Global Map* data is available on the Internet. It is free for non-profit purposes.
