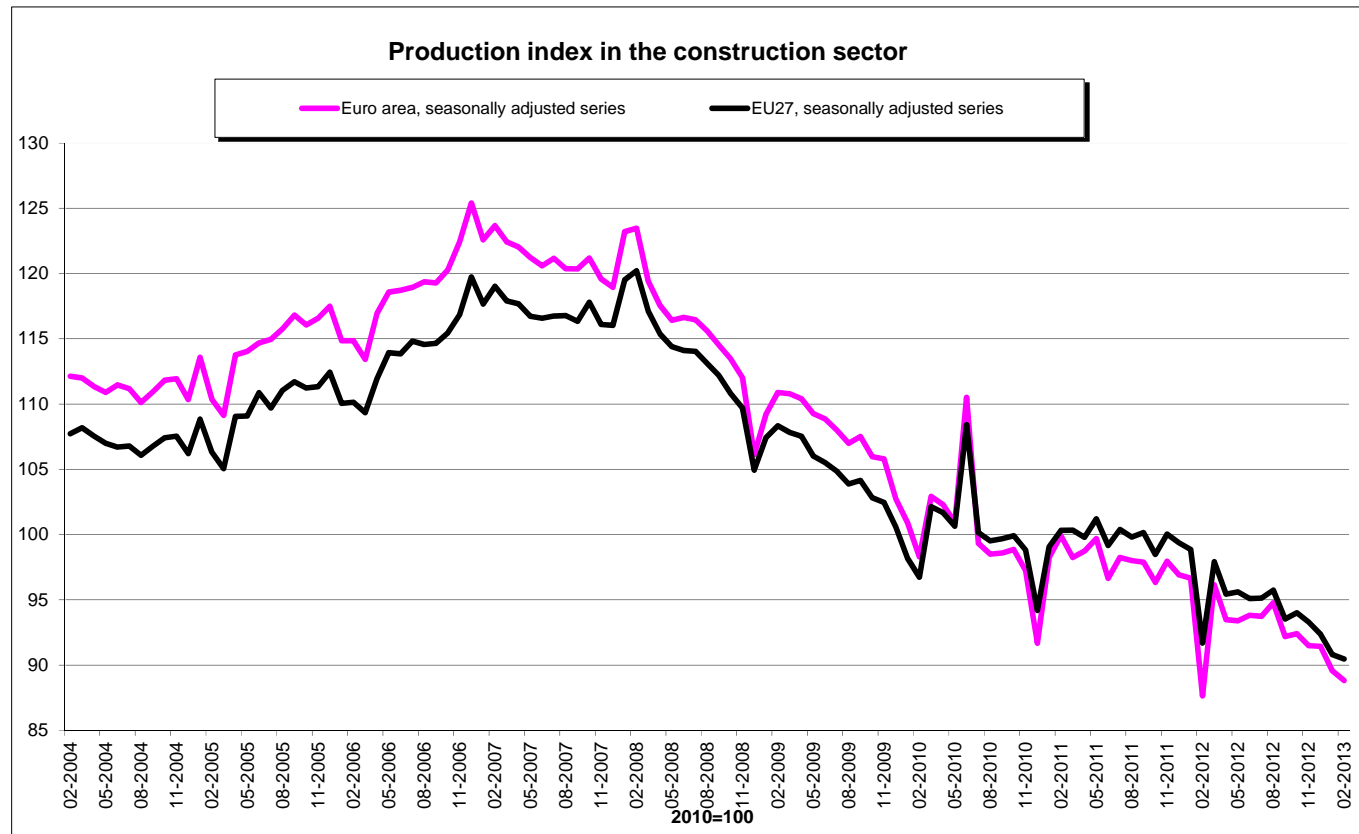
February 2013 compared with January 2013

## Euro area production in construction down by 0.8%

Down by 0.4% in EU27

In the construction sector, seasonally adjusted production<sup>1</sup> fell by 0.8% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA17) and by 0.4% in the **EU27**<sup>2</sup> in February 2013, compared with the previous month, according to first estimates released by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In January 2013<sup>3</sup>, production declined by 2.1% in the **euro area** and by 1.7% in the **EU27**.

Compared with February 2012, production in February 2013 increased by 0.8% in the **euro area**, but dropped by 1.1% in the **EU27**.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for February 2013, production in construction fell in three, remained stable in **Spain** and rose in ten. The decreases were registered in **Poland** (-3.0%), **Germany** (-2.7%) and **Portugal** (-0.8%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+5.0%), **Slovakia** (+4.1%) and **Sweden** (+3.4%).

Building construction increased by 0.4% in the **euro area** and by 0.6% in the **EU27**, after -1.5% in both zones in January 2013. Civil engineering fell by 1.6% in the **euro area** and by 1.3% in the **EU27**, after -4.4% and -2.7% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for February 2013, production in construction rose in six and fell in eight. The highest increases were registered in **France** (+8.7%), **Bulgaria** (+7.8%), **Hungary** (+7.1%) and **Germany** (+6.2%), and the largest decreases in **Portugal** (-20.9%), **Poland** (-13.1%), **Slovenia** (-11.3%) and the **Netherlands** (-7.8%).

Building construction increased by 0.9% in the **euro area**, but dropped by 0.8% in the **EU27**, after -8.8% and -8.6% respectively in January 2013. Civil engineering rose by 0.3% in the **euro area** and fell by 1.4% in the **EU27**, after -10.4% and -9.6% respectively in the previous month.

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. For the Member States which produce the construction index, but do not provide data for the reference period, Eurostat estimates missing values in order to calculate euro area and EU aggregates.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data.

2. The euro area (EA17) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 44/2013 of 19 March 2013. The monthly growth rates for January 2013 have been revised from -1.4% to -2.1% in the euro area and from -1.3% to -1.7% in the EU27. The annual growth rates have been revised from -9.1% to -9.0% in the euro area and from -9.5% to -8.9% in the EU27.
4. Due to the change of base year, data for Belgium are confidential until publication by the National Statistical Institute.
