Accessibility during Late-night/Early-morning Hours at Haneda Airport further improves!

~Airport Shuttle Bus routes expand with more stops~

- O Tokyo International Airport (Haneda Airport) is open 24 hours/7days a week, with the number of domestic and international passengers exceeding 70 million annually. In order to keep pace with the increasing foreign visitors to Japan, it is required to increase the number of flights and passengers during late-night/early-morning hours (11:00pm 6:00am), during which the airport can receive more flights.
- O In order to increase the number of flights and passengers during the said hours, it is crucial to improve accessibility to and from the airport. Therefore Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) and Tokyo Metropolitan Government were working together to support the bus companies to operate trial shuttle bus services on the 5 routes between Haneda Airport and central Tokyo and Yokohama from Oct. 2014 to March 2015. The number of bus passengers has been increasing steadily since the shuttle bus services have started, achieving certain results.
- On the basis of these results, during 2015FY (Apr. March 2016) and beyond, the newly established council consisting of academic experts, airlines, airport terminal companies, etc. giving bus companies grants shall continue and expand the shuttle bus services during the said hours to further improve accessibility to and from Haneda Airport as below.
 - 1 The number of shuttle bus routes will be increased from 5 with 13 stops to 7 with 30 stops.
 - 2 3 routes for late-night bus, departing from the domestic terminal via international terminal will be newly set up.
 - 3 3 free shuttle bus services between the international and domestic terminals will be available.
- O MLIT will continue to improve accessibility to and from Haneda Airport so as to further increase the number of flights and passengers during late-night/early-morning hours.
