NRFA releases K23m for road maintenance

THE National Road Fund Agency (NRFA) has
disbursed K23 million for routine maintenance
of various road projects and related activities across the country.

NRFA spokesperson Alphonsius Hamachila said in a statement yesterday that the funds were paid out last week to ensure Government's projects for routine maintenance of roads and related activities in the

country are accelerated.
